


Comfort comes in many shapes



- Plastic shell with an appealing texture, seatupholstered, front-upholstered and fully upholstered
- > Upholstery can be in fabrics or leather
- ➤ The plastic shell is available in 10 different colours: Anthracite, Grey, White, Baby Blue, Grey Green, Golden Yellow, Antique Pink, Sand, Dark Warm Grey and Coral Red

Frame options

- **>** Cantilever
- > Four-leg with armrests
- > Four-leg without armrests
- Sled base
- > Trestle base polished aluminium
- > Five-star base polished aluminium
- > Trestle base wood
- > Four-leg wood

Frame appearance

- **>** Chrome
- Lacquered
- > Wood (oak natural, beech whitewash, walnut)
- > Frames can be lacquered in the same colour as the plastic seat shell, creating a 'ton sur ton' chair
